- 3. Report from Campus President Jennifer Orlikoff
 - Graduation update: WV commission has come back with guidelines. Still needs 6ft, which is workable.
 - Vaccines are now open to all WVU members.
 - Will not mandate it for students in the fall due to how it has been approved by the FDA/USDA.
 - SWOT teams are meeting now and gathering items for data collection.
 - C. Pritts will be the Liberal Arts chair.
 - G. Wilcox question: Is the vaccine open to the community? Not really- we are open to family members of employees if there are excess doses in a vial. After that, open to the community.
- 4. Report from Dean of Academic Affairs Greg Ochoa
 - Surgical Tech program has gone through curriculum committee, still needs to go to senate, BOG, and so on. We will not offer it in the fall, but will open it in 2022. This will give us more time to promote it and to run a large marketing plan.
 - Met today with Melissa Latimer (associate provost) and Chris Staples. Chat link re: formal review of deans and admin. We will be doing an informal review as a formative assessment. They do not want to go forward with this as it is against policy.
 - Compromise option: Survey on 4/19, open for one week, then Chris and Melissa will meet with Ochoa to go over areas for improvement. They do not want to release the raw data. They do not want to meet with us. Questions will remain the same.

 - Outstanding Professor nominees: 63 ballots, 23 faculty were nominated. Not all will follow through to create a file, but we encourage everyone to do so. (We average 18-25 nominations each year. Digital submissions do not seem to affect this. Digital ballots seemed to go over well.)
 - FEC met on 4/7 to discuss local performance of the dean. Looking at the process, spirit seems to be continuing. Divisions were able to put forward their concerns.
